

<b>TRUMPET 1</b> Revelation 8:7 The first angel sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast <u>upon the earth</u> : and the third part of trees was burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up.	<b>VIAL 1</b> Revelation 16:2 And the first went, and poured out his vial <u>upon the earth</u> ; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and upon them which worshipped his image.
<b>TRUMPET 2</b> Revelation 8:8-9 And the second angel sounded, and as it were a great mountain burning with fire was cast <u>into the sea</u> : and the third part of the sea became blood; 9 And the third part of the creatures which were in the sea, and had life, died; and the third part of the ships were destroyed.	<b>VIAL 2</b> Revelation 16:3 And the second angel poured out his vial <u>upon the sea</u> ; and it became as the blood of a dead man: and every living soul died in the sea.
<b>TRUMPET 3</b> Revelation 8:10-11 And the third angel sounded, and there fell a great star from heaven, burning as it were a lamp, and it fell upon the third part <u>of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters</u> ; 11 And the name of the star is called Wormwood: and the third part of the waters became wormwood; and many men died of the waters, because they were made bitter.	<b>VIAL 3</b> Revelation 16:4-6 And the third angel poured out his vial <u>upon the rivers and fountains of waters</u> ; and they became blood. 5 And I heard the angel of the waters say, Thou art righteous, O Lord, which art, and wast, and shalt be, because thou hast judged thus. 6 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and thou hast given them blood to drink; for they are worthy.
<b>TRUMPET 4</b> Revelation 8:12 And the fourth angel sounded, and the third part <u>of the sun</u> was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the stars; so as the third part of them was darkened, and the day shone not for a third part of it, and the night likewise.	<b>VIAL 4</b> Revelation 16:8-9 And the fourth angel poured out his vial <u>upon the sun</u> ; and power was given unto him to scorch men with fire. 9 And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: and they repented not to give him glory.
<b>TRUMPET 5</b> Revelation 9:1-2 And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit. 2 And he opened the bottomless pit; and there arose a smoke out of the pit, as the smoke of a great furnace; and the sun and the air were <u>darkened</u> by reason of the smoke of the pit.	<b>VIAL 5</b> Revelation 16:10-11 And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast; and his kingdom was full of <u>darkness</u> ; and they gnawed their tongues for pain, 11 And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds.

<b>TRUMPET 6</b>	<b>VIAL 6</b>
Revelation 9:13-15 And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God, 14 Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in <u>the great river Euphrates</u> . 15 And the four angels were loosed, which were prepared for an hour, and a day, and a month, and a year, for to slay the third part of men.	Revelation 16:12 And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon <u>the great river Euphrates</u> ; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.
<b>TRUMPET 7</b>	<b>VIAL 7</b>
Revelation 11:15-19 And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. 16 And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped God, 17 Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned. 18 And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth. 19 And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were <u>lightnings</u> , and <u>voices</u> , and <u>thunderings</u> , and an <u>earthquake</u> , and <u>great hail</u> .	Revelation 16:17-21 And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done. 18 And there were <u>voices</u> , and <u>thunders</u> , and <u>lightnings</u> ; and there was a <u>great earthquake</u> , such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great. 19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath. 20 And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found. 21 And there fell upon men a <u>great hail</u> out of heaven, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great.
